A possible sympathy strike related to the ongoing icebreaker strike will not affect Viking Line's passenger service

The Finnish Seafarers' Union and the Finnish Engineers' Association have announced that the ongoing icebreaker strike may possible be expanded, with a sympathy strike beginning on Thursday, April 2 at 2.00 p.m. These supportive actions will not affect Viking Line's passenger services.

In case the sympathy strike breaks out, the Finnish-flagged vessels Amorella, Viking Grace, Mariella, Gabriella and Rosella would not transport cargo. However, the strike would not affect passenger car traffic or buses that transport passengers.
