

Dear freight customers,

Despite the current situation and concerns about the corona virus, we continue service on our most important routes. Taking the security of supply for Finland and Åland as well as the cargo transport demands into consideration, we will continue freight traffic between Helsinki and Tallinn as well as on the Turku-Åland-Stockholm route. We follow the instructions of the authorities under the state of emergency prevailing in Finland with restrictions on cross-border traffic.

Now, if ever, people see the important role of freight traffic in our society. Below you will find information on our currently available traffic services."

Turku – Åland – Stockholm

Service on the Turku-Åland–Stockholm route will continue as before. Our vessels on the route, M/S Viking Grace and M/S Amorella, continue their morning and evening departures as they have done for years. We have, however, made one minor change: the daytime stopover in Åland will be take place in Långnäs instead of Mariehamn. The timetable is the same as before.
